- A kindergarten teacher (from a piloting school if the district is participating in the pilot)
- District level person responsible for providing ongoing support to kindergarten teachers (i.e. lead coach or coaching supervisor)
- Additional Considerations
 - OEL Kindergarten Demonstration Program Teacher (if applicable)
 - FirstSchool Kindergarten Teacher (if applicable)
